AOB: On the Seventh European Political Community Summit held on October 2nd 2025 in Copenhagen

Thank you, Chair,

I would like to briefly inform the Permanent Council about the Seventh Summit of the European Political Community (EPC), which was held on the 2nd of October 2025 in Copenhagen, co-chaired by the President of the European Council and the Prime Minister of Denmark.

The EPC once again showed its value by bringing together more than 50 heads of state and government, leaders of the EU institutions and international organisations, also including the OSCE Secretary General.

The road towards a strong and secure Europe in a new geopolitical reality was at the top of the agenda. The EPC was formed in the wake of Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine, and aims to ensure political dialogue across the European Continent. The summit had a particular focus on how to strengthen Ukraine against Russia's war of aggression, with President Zelensky as a key note speaker.

To quote Prime Minister Mette Frederiksen: "We have one task ahead of us. We have to make Europe as strong as possible. That calls for unity. Rearmament. Political determination to find solutions across our continent. And a joint understanding of support to Ukraine as an investment in the defence of Europe".

Chair,

Denmark was honoured to host such an important high-level event at a crucial time for the future of Europe. While the summit was successfully conducted, it took place against the backdrop of a series of drone activities in past weeks. In light of this, we are very grateful to our partners who provided assistance to the Danish authorities, bolstering our defence and resilience capacities.

In conclusion, Denmark would like to express our gratitude to all the participants in the EPC summit for the productive exchanges and important discussions.

We look forward to the next summit in 2026, which will be held in Armenia.
