## **STATEMENT BY THE DELEGATION OF ALBANIA**

Thank you, Madam Chairperson,

In response to the statement made by the Delegation of the Russian Federation at the 674th plenary meeting, I would like to make the following statement:

In 2007 and 2008, the Government of Albania, in reference to UN General Assembly resolution 64/54, submitted the requested reports, stating that it neither exported nor imported any equipment in the seven categories comprised by the United Nations Register of Conventional Arms for the calendar years 2006 and 2007.

In the years 2007 and 2008, Albania, for technical reasons, did not submit such reports to the OSCE. We would like to confirm that the reports submitted to the UN for this period are valid for the OSCE as well. In this regard, on 20 February, we distributed to all the OSCE participating States Note Verbale No. 82, dated 20 February 2012, attaching the relevant reports.

As a participating State, Albania is firmly committed to implementing all agreed documents of the OSCE, thereby contributing to transparency and confidence-building measures within the zone of application of CSBMs.

I request that this statement be attached to the journal of the day.
